






2 key themes in 1 Corinthians:

A letter is a communication from Writer to Reader in specific time/context with specific message.





Timeless Teachings:

- 1. No requirement to wear veils/covering today
- 2. Paul not concerned about women speaking publicly but about men and women being differentiated by what they wear – can't be gender neutral.
